5. Timeline must contain important information of women spacefarers.
6. Final timeline design must contain SUPARCO and WSW logo.
7. The judgment will be based on creativity, design and relevancy.
8. High resolution picture of the timeline must be submitted along with submission form at wsw.sead.pakistan@gmail.com.
9. Last date for submission is **23 Oct 21**

How do I win?

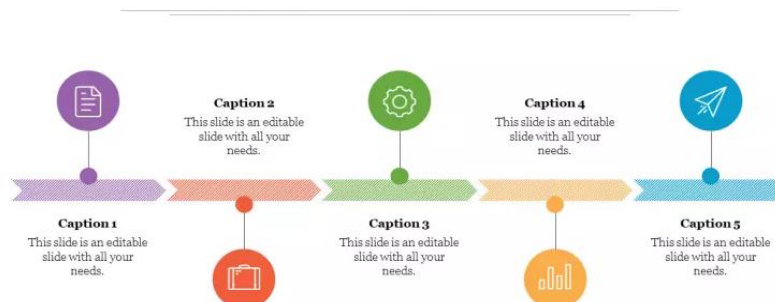
To be eligible for winning the competition, the challenge and submission requirements must be met as per details mentioned above.

Judging Scorecard

The judging panel will rank the submitted entries using the following Judging Scorecard:

Metric	Weightage
Challenge fulfillment as per rules and guidelines	50%
Creativity, design, relevancy and novelty	25%
Submission as per format and form	25%

How to Create a Timeline



Timeline diagrams present events during specific intervals shown chronologically along a line. Timelines are designed to provide a broad overview of a sequence of events in time. They don't go into detail, but links to events, information and images may be added as needed.

A timeline diagram consists of a horizontal bar or line representing time progressing from left to right. This bar is marked with events or steps to indicate when they should or did happen. Timelines are most useful for showing important milestones and deadlines.

How to Make Timeline

- Every timeline should have a title identifying the project or historic events it illustrates. Place a fitting title at the top of the page.
- Decide what segment of time you want to illustrate. Make a horizontal line or bar in the center of the page. Place the start and end dates at each end of the line going from left to right.
- Add events/info along a horizontal line that represents any time period you define. Add text, photos where necessary.
- Use lines and arrows to pinpoint special events and details.
- Use pictures to further illustrate an event or task on the timeline. This can add clarity and increase the visual appeal of your timeline
